Like family and community support, access to substance abuse and mental health treatment, stable employment is critical to rehabilitation. We all benefit when individuals formerly involved with the justice system are able to obtain employment earning family-sustaining wage. Conversely, if reentry fails, we all pay the price. About the Speakers:

Jason Barnum is a Monroe County Reentry Coordinator with Delphi with over 14 years' experience working in re-entry and with young involved in the foster care system. He currently manages a team of coordinators who support previously incarcerated adults linking them with employment, education, treatment, housing, and other individualized needs.

Alice Haskins is the Ontario County Chief Corrections Officer. She has achieved a number of accomplishments in her career including becoming the first female jail administrator in NYS, achieving the first jail accreditation, acting as a jail accreditation assessor, and being named 2017 Corrections Officer of the Year.

Gregory Maine is the Coordinator of Incarcerated Education, Adult Literacy and Health Care Programs for Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES. Over the past several years Greg has worked closely with other service providers in the correctional facilities, as well as WIOA partner agencies to provide for the transitional needs of individuals in, and transitioning from, area jails.
